This elegant, three storey lightweight timber building sits atop a heritage listed wharf in the Victoria Harbour precinct in Melbourne. The Library at the Dock enriches the precinct through access to activity, communication, collaboration, history and the creative arts.

INEX>FLOOR was used as the finished product for the floor access ducts connecting the 2 services cores of the building; thereby future proofing the building for services and data upgrades.
